Terms and Conditions

1. Entry is open to all Tasmanian primary schools and primary school students schooled from home.
 2. Entries must have been created by the entrant.
 3. Entries must be submitted as an A3 size poster, using any art material, including: paint, collage, pencil or computer graphics.
- Entries must reach Multicultural Council by 4.00pm Monday 5th March, 2018
 - Entries can be dropped off at Hobart office or posted to 65 Hopkins Street ,MoonahTAS 7009.
- No extension to this date will be granted.
4. Multicultural Council reserves the right not to submit an entry for judging if it does not meet the entry criteria.
 5. All entries will be evaluated in good faith by a judging panel selected by MCOT. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into about the evaluation or the decision of the judging panel or the processes in connection with the evaluation or decision.
 6. By submitting the entry form, entrants will assign a limited copyright of the image to MCOT enabling reproduction of the image for public displays and publications (both printed and digital) in conjunction with the competition AND for the purpose of publication in printed and digital material promoting Harmony week.
 7. Artists will be credited whenever the posters are used.
 8. Submitted artwork will not be returned to the entrant unless otherwise requested and arranged with MCOT
 9. By entering this competition, the entrant agrees that if their poster is selected, their first name and initial, year level, age, school name may be used for promotional purposes. All other personal information will remain confidential.
 10. Entries from students under the age of 18 must have adult consent.
 11. Signing the entry form for this competition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
 12. Failure to provide contact details for entry into the MCOT Harmony Week Poster competition will constitute an invalid entry.
 14. Entries received in each region (north, north west and south) will be judged and the first three place getters in each category will be submitted as part of a short list for final state-wide judging.
 15. Certificates of commendation will be provided to each of the regional finalists.
 16. Winners of the final state-wide judging will be announced during Harmony Week, 18th – 25th March 2018. The selected winning students' schools will be contacted and informed.
 17. Prizes will be announced by Mid February 2018.
